The multi-sport course – An adventure for everyone

Next to the golf course is the multi-sport-course, follow

Kick - hit - or throw, it's your choice!

Our multi-sport course is open to everyone.

Soccer golf/foot golf, short hole golf, frisbee golf/disc golf is fun and involves kicking, hitting or throwing from a tee to the hole in as few strokes as possible.

Prices:

- Members of Solön golf club and children 0-5 play for free
- 6-16 years 20 SEK / day
- 16-100 SEK 50/day
- Weekly card = SEK 200/family
- Season ticket = SEK 500/family

Good Things To know

- The course is built to play disc-frisbee golf / soccer golf / golf with an iron club
- You need to bring your own equipment such as balls, protocols and pens.
- It is not permitted to use golf clubs that you hit further than 60 meters



Rules

- The ball/disc is played from where it lies.
- The ball must lie still when struck.
- If the ball gets into the water, you have to scoop it up and call a shot. The ball is placed within one meter of the spot where it entered.
- If the ball/disc gets stuck up in a bush or tree, you may shake the ball/disc down and place it within three meters against a kind of obligation.
- If the ball lands in the hole but bounces out, it does not count as a hole, you continue to play the hole
- The order of play at the tee is determined by the best result on the previous course.
- The order of play after everyone has kicked out is determined by which ball is furthest from the hole.
- If your ball/disc/frisbee is heading towards someone, you shout "FORE"
- If you hear the word "FORE" shouted, crouch down and protect your hood
- Juniors are allowed to tee off 10 adults step into the court
- You must not destroy bushes, trees and branches to improve the position of the ball.
- To keep up the tempo strike, throw or kick MAX 10 Pieces per hole
